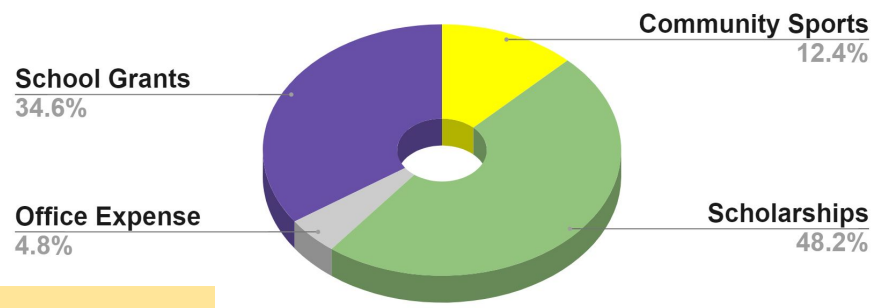
Enrichment Grants
